Logical Learning Lab

- Hands-on courses introduce engineering principles for ages 8-88 using **LEGO®** & **K'NEX®**
- Math, science, and technology combine to teach mechanical & structural principles and a rich vocabulary as students actually build their solutions.
- Each course segment is 7 hrs. and Certificates of Completion are issued when completed.
- High school students may earn high school credits for Logical Learning Lab courses.
- Groups are invited to use our staff and schedule classes at various locations.

Trade Prep Program

- Students become pre-qualified for apprenticeship programs in the construction trades. Students completing courses are eligible to be in the National Registry of the **National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER)**.
- Using NCCER accredited materials:
 - ___ students earn credits in NCCER Core Curriculum, Red Cross CPR & First Responder certification.
 - ___ students earn the 10-hour card for OSHA certification
 - ___ students prepare their "working resume" to use for applying for work.
- Trade Prep introduces masonry, plumbing, electrical, carpentry, heating, A/C, & welding. Completed courses qualify for high school credit.

North Atlantic Regional High School

- In addition to regular courses, NARHS also converts home-school work into high school credits. When the student has acquired the 17-1/2 credits required, he or she is eligible for a high school diploma, then may earn as many credits as they wish before graduating.
- NARHS has students in all 50 states & accepts transfer credits. There are NO Exit Exams, no residency requirements, and the school is state-authorized, state-recognized, and fully accredited nationwide. NARHS maintains fully-staffed offices in Maine, Washington State, and Florida.

Registrar's Office

- This is the essential hub for detailing every proven credit, every credit earned elsewhere, and every credit allowable by law or regulation for every student.
- High school credits belong to the student, not the school. Each student decides what to do with his or her credits.
- The Registrar's Office coordinates all official transcripts, contacts with high schools, colleges, employers, & military recruiters.
- The Registrar's Office serves all of the high schools operated and associated with National Education Developers.

HomeLink Education

- Classes for homeschoolers grades 7-12 are taught by qualified teachers and are held each week. Parents pay for this service, and the HomeLink staff is paid.
- Each course is taught one day a week using the "college model" of learning. HomeLink has local classes in NJ, WA, MO, and FL.
- For grades 7-12, courses in Math, English, Science, & History are offered. And, each quarter, numerous high-interest electives are available.
- Some Trade Prep classes are held at HomeLink locations.
- Completed HomeLink courses are eligible for high school credit.
